



Multi-Sensory Group Tutoring In Reading, Writing and Spelling

- ◆ A unique program for students aged 6 to 10 with severe reading difficulties (dyslexia) that uses all the learning pathways to the brain (including visual, auditory, kinesthetic and tactile) simultaneously in order to enhance memory and learning.
- ◆ This multi-sensory approach to tutoring is a structured, systematic and sequential program that will teach language skills through phonemic awareness
- ◆ A positive, nurturing group environment will build self-esteem and confidence
- ◆ Students attend one-hour sessions , twice a week
- ◆ Small group tutoring (4 per group)
- ◆ Students' reading skills are assessed prior to registration
- ◆ Grouped according to reading level
