



Summer One to One Tutoring Program

- ◆ Trained tutors will work one to one with students aged 7 to 14 to improve their literacy and/or math skills. Any student who is at least one year behind in reading, writing or math achievement is eligible for this program. Choose from either program; or sign up for both.

ONE TO ONE MATH TUTORING - Tutoring will provide help for students who are having difficulty with any area of the elementary Math curriculum, or who simply need to practice their skills over the summer months.

ONE TO ONE LITERACY TUTORING - Tutoring will provide skill development in the areas of reading, spelling, comprehension and writing.

- ◆ Student progress is monitored by a special education teacher
- ◆ We supply all tutoring materials and books from our own library
- ◆ Students' reading or math skills are assessed on the first class
- ◆ This is not an ESL or homework study program.
