# Building Social Skills and Friendships

Is a small group program for children with LD or ADD using Integrated Movement Therapy™, a holistic approach intended to treat the “whole child”, including social and language deficits, sensory integration difficulties, anxiety, poor motor coordination and body awareness, self-esteem, and overall well-being.

- ✓ Two age groups for 9-12 and 12-15
- ✓ Activities include creative movement, art, crafts, games, dance and group discussions
- ✓ Students will learn a variety of pro-social behaviours, such as encouraging others, accepting differences, communicating clearly, asking for help, following directions and the keys to being a good friend
- ✓ Maximum 12 per group
- ✓ Mondays after-school, once a week, 8 sessions
