# MULTI SENSORY GROUP TUTORING

## for Reading, Writing and Spelling

*A Program designed to use all the learning pathways (including visual, auditory, kinesthetic and tactile) to the brain simultaneously in order to enhance memory and learning. Based on the Orton-Gillingham approach.*

- ❖ For students in grades 1 to 5 who struggle with learning to read or are dyslexic
- ❖ Orton-Gillingham based multi-sensory approach that teaches language skills through phonemic awareness
- ❖ A positive, nurturing environment will build self-esteem and confidence
- ❖ Students will be assessed prior to placement in the program and grouped according to skill level
- ❖ Students attend after-school twice a week on Wednesdays and Fridays,
- ❖ Small groups—A ratio of 2 tutors to 4 students

Dates: February 3 to June 9, 2010, Wednesdays & Fridays

Times: After-school one-hour sessions, times confirmed after assessment

Location: LDAFS Resource Centre, #201-13766 –72 Avenue, Surrey

Fees: \$15 per session\* (total 32 sessions—payable monthly)
