Multi-Sensory Math with Manipulatives

Group Tutoring Program

- ◆ A remedial program intended for struggling students in grades 3 to 7 including those identified as have learning disabilities.
- ◆ Hands-On Activities help students build a bridge from the concrete manipulatives to the traditional math curricula
- ◆ Success-oriented: Students build confidence as they work towards mastery of basic math concepts
- ◆ Students attend one-hour sessions , twice a week
- ◆ Small group tutoring (4 per group)
- ◆ Prior math assessment determines skill level and eligibility
- ◆ Grouped according to skill level
