



Real Reading Tutoring Program

- ◆ A remedial tutoring program for children who are at least one year behind in their reading, comprehension, spelling and/or writing skills.
- ◆ Trained tutors work one-to-one with students aged 7-13 under the supervision of an experienced, certified teacher. We use prepared lesson plans which meet student needs by providing a particular focus. For example:
 - ⇒ Phonics instruction for beginners
 - ⇒ Reading strategies for building fluency
 - ⇒ Comprehension exercises to promote understanding and help students organize their ideas
 - ⇒ Written responses which enable students to progress in spelling, as well as sentence and paragraph structure
- ◆ In each lesson, students will read a book, answer questions about their reading or respond in writing. Spelling instruction is based on vocabulary encountered in reading.
- ◆ We supply all tutoring materials and books from our own library or appropriate books from Surrey public libraries.
- ◆ Students' reading skills are assessed prior to registration
- ◆ This is not an ESL or homework study program.
